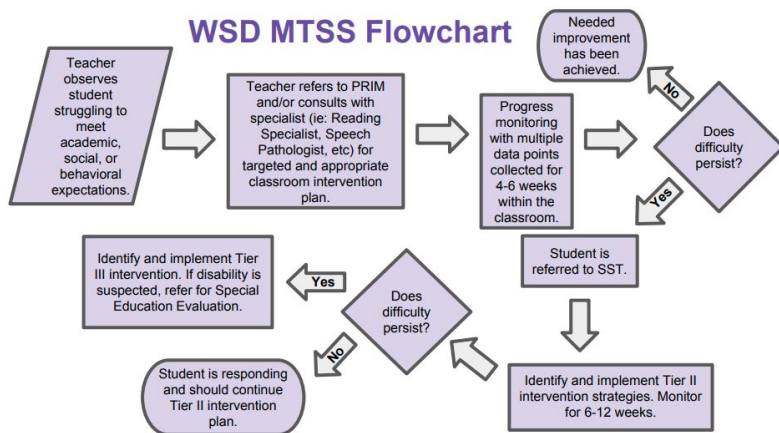




Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS)

What is MTSS?

MTSS establishes a process for providing increasing levels of instructional frequency and intensity whereby the needs of all learners are identified and supported.



All students are provided effective standards-based core instruction and best practices in a system that includes: universal screening, progress monitoring, data-driven decision-making, academic, social-emotional, behavior supports, and researched based instruction and intervention.

What are the tiers of MTSS?

Tier 3 Intensive Intervention

1. Intensive, targeted, evidence-based intervention designed to close identified deficits in very small groups.
2. Students are progress monitored at least weekly and their progress is reviewed to ensure the intervention is appropriate and effective.
3. Students in Tier 3 will receive interventions in conjunction with and in addition to all components of Tier 1 core instruction.
4. May be delivered by RtI teacher, Reading Specialist, School Counselors & other related services providers (OT, PT, speech, behavior, Special educators).

Tier 2 Supplement to Core Instruction

1. Students performing below their grade-level peers (lowest 10-20%) may access targeted instruction and support delivered in small groups.
2. Students are progress monitored bi-weekly and their achievement is reviewed to ensure intervention is appropriate, effective, and at a pace that will close the deficit in the shortest amount of time.
3. Students in this tier will receive interventions in conjunction with and in addition to all components of Tier 1 core instruction.
4. May be delivered by the Classroom teacher, Interventionists, RtI Teacher, Reading Specialists, School Counselor and related service providers.

Tier 1 Core Instruction

1. All student receive effective standards-based, evidence-based instruction aligned with standards and behavior supports.
2. May be delivered by classroom teachers and School Counselors.
